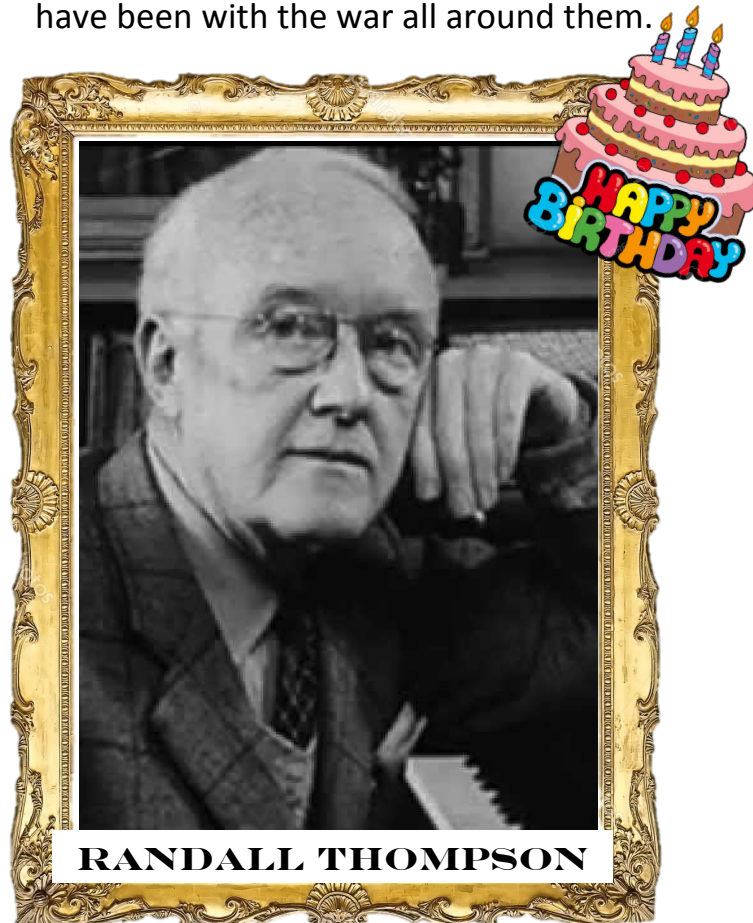

# Composer of the Month:

## RANDALL THOMPSON

Happy birthday this month to Randall Thompson, American composer born in April of 1899! He's a 20<sup>th</sup> Century composer, which means as far as music is concerned, pretty much anything is ok! His most famous work is a song called "Alleluia." This is a very sad piece. There is only one word in the whole song – alleluia, then finally at the end – amen. Thompson wrote this song in 1940 and was thinking about World War II and how sad the people in Europe must have been with the war all around them.
