"Basic Homemade Instrument Ideas"

1. Drum

Use an empty oatmeal or coffee container and a wooden spoon or pencils for drum sticks.



2. Maracas:

Fill an empty plastic Easter egg with beads, rice, or another filler. Add two plastic spoons with tape to give your shaker a handle and really turn it into a maraca.





3. Tambourine
Punch holes around
the edge of 2 face-to-face
paper plates and
tie jingle bells all around it.

4. Guiro

Scrape an empty ridged water bottle with a stick. Swirl paint around the inside first to make it really pretty!



5. Kazoo

Cover end of cardboard tube with wax paper, affix it with a rubber band and hum through the other end.
